**CSU General Education Breadth Requirements and

SRJC will certify completion of 39 units of the 48-unit GE requirement for graduation from the CSU for students meeting the follow pattern. The remaining 9 units must be taken in upper division at the degree granting institution. A minimum of 30 units in GE, including all of Areas A and B4, with grades of C or better in each course must be completed prior to transfer. A "P" grade is acceptable, as at SRJC "P" = "C" grade or higher.

2023- 2024 NOTES ON CSU GENERAL EDUCATION- BREADTH REQUIREMENTS

Students having 60 transferable semester units with a "C" average (2.0) will be eligible to transfer to a California State University providing a minimum of 30 units in GE, including all of Areas A and B4, is completed with grades of C or better (or P). SRJC courses ~~cannot~~ transfer to the CSU for units. At some CSUs, GE completion may be a factor in admission to certain majors. Talk to your counselor about your major and target CSU campuses.
