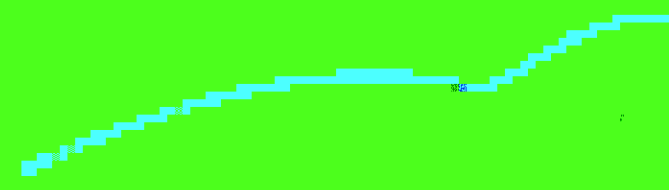
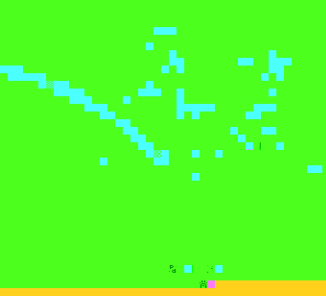

WHEREAS, the Governor's budget proposal is \$97 million short of the CSU Board of request;

WHEREAS, an additional \$97 million would fund an increase in enrollment of 12,000 CSU to undertake \$250 million worth of critical maintenance needs and provide \$30 million for student success and completion efforts; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, California State University, East Bay, supports the university and recognizes its importance in providing a high quality education to their families, their communities and the state of California; and

WHEREAS, California State University, East Bay asks the Legislature to provide at least \$97 million in funding for the CSU above the Governor's January Budget
