WHEREAS,

The Associated Students of Cal State East Bay (ASCEB) is a student organization

composed of approximately 1,500 students from various majors and ethnicities who are involved in the daily operations of the university. ASCEB is a non-profit organization that receives no funding from the university and is entirely funded by its members through the ASBZ fee.

ASCEB has been providing services to students for over 50 years, including academic support, social activities, and advocacy for student issues. We believe that it is important for students to have a voice in the decision-making process of the university, and we strive to provide opportunities for students to engage in meaningful activism and advocacy.

We are currently facing a significant challenge in funding our operations, as the university has proposed a new fee structure that would reduce our ASBZ fee by 25%. This reduction would have a significant impact on our ability to provide services to students, particularly those from low-income backgrounds.

We believe that it is essential for the university to recognize the value of student organizations like ASCEB in providing services to students. We urge the university to reconsider its proposed fee structure and to work with us to find a solution that ensures we can continue to provide services to students.
