ADMISSION CRITERIA

After Applicants are sorted into priority groups (see previous page), the application review continues. Applicants earn points based on the criteria listed below.

REQUIRED CRITERIA

• Prerequisite GPA based on submitted transcripts** Science prerequisites - 7-year recency requirement.



ABOUT THE NURSING PROGRAM

The Pre-Licensure program is a full-time, daytime undergraduate program for candidates new to Nursing. LVN's may apply to this program.

The Pre-Licensure HAYWARD Nursing Program begins in the fall, and the CONCORD Nursing Program starts in the spring.

ELIGIBILITY

The number of students interested in entering the Pre-Licensure Nursing Program is greater than space available in clinical courses. This impacted program has additional eligibility and selection criteria beyond those required for university admission. Minimum eligibility consists of the following (please note that meeting minimum eligibility requirements does not guarantee admission).

- 1. Submit transcripts with final grades for all required prerequisites by deadline and meet recency requirement. Grades of C and above are acceptable (a grade of C- is too low).
- 2. GPA of at least 3.00 in the following: ALL prerequisite courses combined AND Just the FOUR SCIENCE prerequisites
- 3. Minimum 70% overall TEAS score. Minimum 65% on English/Reading sections of TEAS. Online / Remote TEAS is accepted. Order from ATI and send the official TEAS score to
