

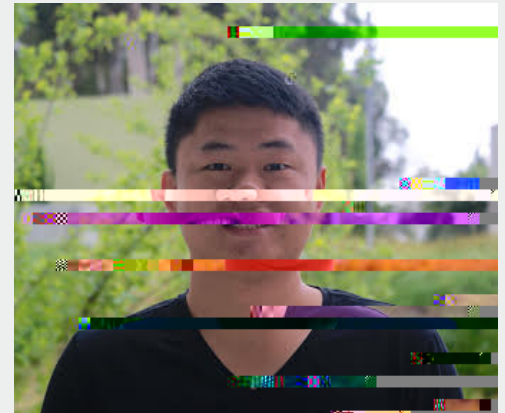
California State University, East Bay (CSUEB) offers conditional admission to undergraduates who are academically qualified but have not met the English language requirement. Students are issued an I-20 by the American Language Program (ALP)/Global Academy and a conditional admission letter indicating that the student will be admitted to a University undergraduate program upon meeting the English language requirement and successful completion of Global Academy coursework.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Year-round schedule
- 8 week program*
- 7 levels of instruction
- University Preparation Program
 - Weekly courses that prepare students for their first year at CSUEB
 - Workshops and activities for students to practice communication skills in an academic setting
 - University degree counseling and admissions advising
- Courses in Reading/Writing, Listening/Speaking, and Grammar
- Skills courses in preparation for academic studies
- Courses that prepare students to take the IELTS/TOEFL exams
- TOEFL score of 61 (ibt), or IELTS score of 6.0 or higher
- Must also meet the following requirements:
 - 12 years Elementary and Secondary Schooling - Minimum 3.0 GPA or B (requires high school diploma or certificate of completion of secondary education)
 - Minimum 2.0 GPA or C

*Note: Five 8-week Intensive English sessions per year (Two 8-week sessions per semester and an 8-week summer session.)
