

Audiology – Experience in Audiometric Screenings & Hearing Habilitation or Rehabilitation

There is no minimum requirement of contact hours in the minor area of audiology. However, within the graduate training program there will be opportunities to gain training and acquire contact hours in audiometric screenings and in treatment (habilitation and rehabilitation) with the hearing-impaired population, including individuals with conduction or sensorineural losses, with or without assistive devices or cochlear implants. Opportunities to acquire contact hours are distributed across therapy, assessment, and internship practicums as much as possible.
